Scope

The Scope of collaboration on academic and research activities in this Memorandum of Understanding includes the following categories:

- Academic and Research collaboration
- Exchange of academic information, scholarly information, materials and publications.
- Exchange of students and faculty for the self-sponsored College Level Certificate courses, summer training and hands on training.

Research Collaboration

Faculty from both Institutions will collaborate in the supervision of exchange students and in joint research in the disciplines of mutual interest. All such joint research activities will be governed by the terms laid out in **Annexure I**.




Commencement, renewal, termination and amendment

This MOU will come into force upon affixing of the signatures of the representatives of the partner institutions and will remain in effect for five years. This MOU may be renewed upon its expiry, with the agreement of both partner institutions.


Either Party may withdraw at any time from this MOU before the end of the five year period by transmitting a signed writing to that effect to the other Party. This MOU and the partnership created thereby shall be considered terminated thirty (30) days from the date the non-withdrawing Party actually receives the notice of withdrawal from the withdrawing Party.

This MOU or its renewal and the actions taken under it may be reviewed at any time. Modifications may be made by mutual agreement and any amendment or extension to the agreement may be formalized by the exchange of letters between the two parties and will be effective only after signature of both the parties on such modifications.

Annexure I

Rules governing Academic and Research Collaboration between the two institutions

1. Proposals for collaborative research work and other activities under this Memorandum will be submitted with the prior approval of the Head of each institution, or his / her nominee.
2. Each institution will nominate one of its members as its representative in charge of the cooperative program. Individual programs of work under this Memorandum will be jointly planned and conducted by the nominees of both parties.
3. Progress of work of any individual program will be reviewed and approved by the designated authorities of both parties i.e. Heads of the Institutions.
4. The final approval of any project will depend on the availability of guaranteed support i.e. Accommodation and Infrastructure Facilities for Research (by the Host Institution). Financial support required if any (TA/DA/Accommodation) has to be borne by the respective institution of their own side.
5. There will be no financial obligation on any of the institution under this MOU.
6. Students under the student exchange programme will be classified as special exchange students. Special exchange students will be permitted to take College level self-sponsored certificate courses on credit awarded by college, as well as participate in research activities / project work / summer training / hands on training.
7. In any case, the consent of the teacher / project supervisors / research supervisors is required. Such consent will be considered among other things whether the student has pre-requisites for the course / project.
8. Neither institution will charge admission or tuition fee to respective student in exchange of students under this MOU.





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9. Course credits and grades earned will be determined by the home institution based on the grade report from the host institution subject to existing rules and regulations of credit system of affiliating university.
10. Each institution will accept students each year depending upon availability of supervisor, area of interest of respective student and capacity of either institution to accommodate student number.
11. Normally, participants may not spend more than 4 weeks in the exchange programme.
12. Participants will be subjected to the rules and regulations of the host institution.
13. The host institution will evaluate the nomination and determine their suitability for selection under the Student Exchange Program. Where the exchange student is pursuing a research or implementation project as part of the under graduate/ post graduate/ research degree programme, the host institution will provide access to laboratory facilities and suitable faculty member (along with the supervisor in the parent institution) to jointly assist the exchange student in formulating research project or jointly supervising the exchange student in the event that a research project has already been identified.
14. The host institution will inform the home institution about any academic or other problems that may arise during the period of the student's residence in the host institution. The host institution will take appropriate action under its established policy and procedures, in consultation with the home institution to deal with such problems.
15. Both partners of the MOU will not have any objection on the other for individually signing MOU with any other institution.
16. Nothing in this MoU shall be construed to authorize or permit any violation of any Government, State or local/UGC or University law imposed upon the Parties.




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
