on feedback obtained on curriculum from various stakeholders:

KRE Society's Karnatak Arts, Science and Commerce College is affiliated to Gulbarga University, Kalaburagi. The curriculum is developed by Affiliating University by constituting the Board of Studies as per University Grants Commission and Karnataka State Government Guidelines. Therefore, the Institute has very limited role in curriculum design. However, the institute collected the feedback on curriculum from its stake holders such as Students, Staff Members, Alumni and Employers.

The systematically analysed **feedback was discussed in meeting of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell and an extract of the same was forwarded to College Governing Council, for necessary action with some important recommendations.**

Based on the analysis of the report, suggestions are communicated to the affiliating university through members of board of studies of Gulbarga University, Kalaburagi. From, time to time the Principal of the college also raised some issues and gave the feedback on curriculum in Principals' meeting conducted by the affiliating university.



Based on the feedback analysis, the following actions are included in institutions academic activities to enrich the curriculum:

1. Introduction of add-on courses for curriculum enrichment:
