Q. How can I get HIV from swimming pools or hot tubs?  
→ HIV cannot live in a hot tub or swimming pool.  
There have been no cases of HIV transmission through swimming pools or hot tubs.

Q. How can I get HIV from a mosquito bite?  
→ Studies have shown that mosquitoes and other insects do not pass HIV to humans.  
When an insect bites a person, it does not inject its own blood or a previous victim's blood into the new victim. It injects only saliva while the general that cause malaria and other diseases spread by insect bites. HIV does not reproduce (and therefore cannot survive) in insects so, even if the virus enters a mosquito or another sucking insect, the insect does not become infected and cannot pass HIV to the next human that it feeds on or bites.

Q. What is HIV?

→ HIV (Human Immunodeficiency Virus) is a virus you may hear that someone is HIV infected, has HIV infection, or has HIV disease. These are all terms that mean the person has HIV in his or her body and pass the virus to other people.

Q. What is AIDS?

→ Acquired Immune Deficiency Syndrome is a late stage of HIV disease. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), a person with HIV infection has AIDS when two or more of the following conditions are met:  
\* has a CD4 cell count (a way to measure the strength of the immune system) that falls below 200 or a normal CD4 cell count is 500 or higher.





55 How is HIV spread from one person to another?  
→ HIV is spread when infected blood, semen, vaginal fluid or breast milk gets into the bloodstream of another person through

\* direct entry into a blood vessel.

\* mucous linings, such as the vagina, rectum, penis, mouth, eyes, or nose; or

\* a break in the skin.

HIV is not spread through saliva (spit)

HIV is spread in the following ways:

\* Women with HIV infection can pass HIV to their babies during pregnancy, delivery, and breastfeeding.

\* has no symptoms of HIV

\* has not been diagnosed with HIV/AIDS

\* is taking HIV medicine; or

69 Who should get tested for HIV?

→ your health care provider is required to offer HIV testing to all persons between the ages of 13 and 64, regardless of apparent risk. You are strongly encouraged to accept testing.

\* There are treatments for HIV/AIDS that can help a person stay healthy.

\* people with HIV/AIDS can use safe practices to protect others from becoming infected with

safe practices also protect people with HIV/AIDS from being infected with different strains of HIV.

\* Discrimination based on a person's HIV status is illegal. People who are discriminated against can get help.

\* Consent for HIV-related testing remains in effect until it is withdrawn verbally or in writing. If the consent was given for a specific period of time, the consent.

Q What are CD4 cell counts and viral load tests?

→ CD4 cells are part of the immune system. Over time, HIV kills CD4 cells, making the immune system weaker. A person's CD4 cell count shows the strength or weakness of the immune system.

Viral load is the amount of HIV in a person's blood over time, without treatment. The viral load of a person living with HIV gets higher. HIV treatment with HAART

→ CD4 cell count tests and viral load tests give people with HIV and their doctors important information about a person's HIV infection and immune system strength. These tests help show whether a person should consider taking HAART. HAART is working may also show how well.

\* People with HIV should have a CD4 cell count test and a viral load test done at least every six months. If they are taking HAART, these tests should be done at least every four months.

9) where can people with HIV get medical care  
- Hospital clinics. The New York state Department of Health has identified. Some hospital as designated AIDS centers. because they have special care programs for people with HIV infection and AIDS.

Commonly health centers. many people with HIV receive their medical care from clinics in the community where they live. Some are special programs for children, adolescents, and substance users.

Drug treatment programs. For people with HIV we get care from private doctor-gaming in. Now use some drug treatment programs also provide HIV medical care on site. To find one of these sites near you

Private doctor's offices. people with HIV can get care from private doctors in their community. It is important to see a doctor who is knowledgeable about HIV; sometimes called an HIV experienced provider.

Home care programs. Throughout the state a number of AIDS home care programs provide nursing and other services in the homes of people who have

When an insect bites a person it does not inject its own blood or a previous victim's blood into the new victim  
It injects only saliva unlike the germs that cause malaria and other diseases spread by insect bites HIV does not reproduce in insects so even if the virus enters a mosquito or another sucking or biting insect the insect does not become infected and cannot pass HIV to the next human that it feeds on or bites

⇒ HIV is spread when infected blood semen vaginal fluids or breast milk gets into the blood stream of another person through.

\* Direct entry into a blood vessel

\* a break in the skin

HIV is not spread through saliva (spit)

HIV is spread in the following ways:

\* Having vaginal and/or oral sex without using a condom

\* Sharing needles syringes or works to inject drugs vitamins or hormones steroids or medicines

\* Women with HIV infection can pass HIV to their babies during pregnancy delivery and breast feeding

\* People who are exposed to blood and/or body fluids at work like health care workers may be exposed to HIV through needle sticks or other on the job. It is also possible to pass HIV through

\* Sharing needles for piercing or tattooing

\* has no symptoms of HIV

\* has not been diagnosed with HIV/AIDS

\* Is taking HIV medicine or

\* has an undetectable viral load

HIV is not spread by casual contact like sneezing coughing eating or drinking common utensils shaking hands hugging or using restrooms

drinking fountains swimming pools or hot tubs

How is HIV spread from one person to another  
your health care provider is required to offer HIV testing to all persons between the age of 13 and 64 regardless of apparent risk. you are strongly encouraged to accept testing it may provide you with important information about your important points to know about HIV testing.

HIV is the virus that causes AIDS. It can be spread through unprotected sex with someone who has HIV, contact with HIV infected blood by sharing needles, by HIV-infected pregnant woman to their infants during pregnancy or delivery or by breast feeding. There are treatments for HIV/AIDS that can help a person stay healthy.

Where can people with HIV get medical care

Most HIV individuals have been or will be required to join a Medicaid managed health care plan - however not all persons with HIV will be required to join a plan. A variety of factors may exclude from enrollment in Medicaid managed care at this time including having Medicare and Medicaid or a spend down to qualify for Medicaid HIV uninsured care program or enrolled in a long term care home health care program.

Additionally PLWHA are not required to join a plan unless they live in a county that requires its residents to join a plan. The process to include the HIV+ population in Medicaid managed care began in NYC [August 2010] and will be continued to the rest of New York State in October 2011. If the person lives in NYC they can choose a main stream Medicaid Managed Care plan persons who live in non Medicaid managed care plan that serves their specific

Q1 How is HIV Transmitted
