Annexure I

Rules governing Academic Collaboration between two institutions

- 4. In any case, the consent of the teacher / project supervisor/ research supervisor is required. Such consent will be taken into account among other things whether the student has pre-requisites for the course / project.
- Neither student/faculty will require admission or tuition fees of exchange students under this MOU.
- Course credits and grades earned will be determined by the home institution based on the grade report from the awarding institution.
- Participants will be subjected to the rules and regulations of the host institution, in addition to specific rules and regulations, if any.
- The host institution will evaluate the nomination and determine their suitability for selection under any Programme.
- 9. The host institution will inform the home institution of any technical or other problems that may arise during the period of student's residence in the host institution. The host institution will take appropriate action under its established policy and procedures, in consultation with the home institution to deal with such problems.
- The parent institution will be responsible for the financial budget if any for their respective participants if any.
