

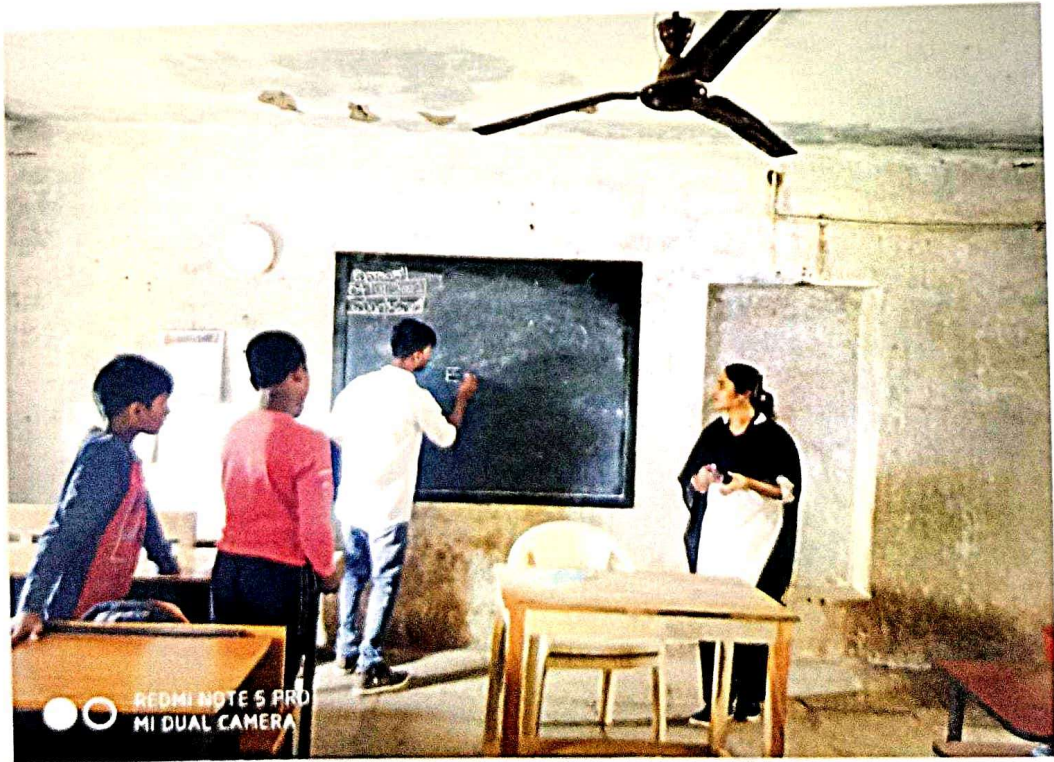
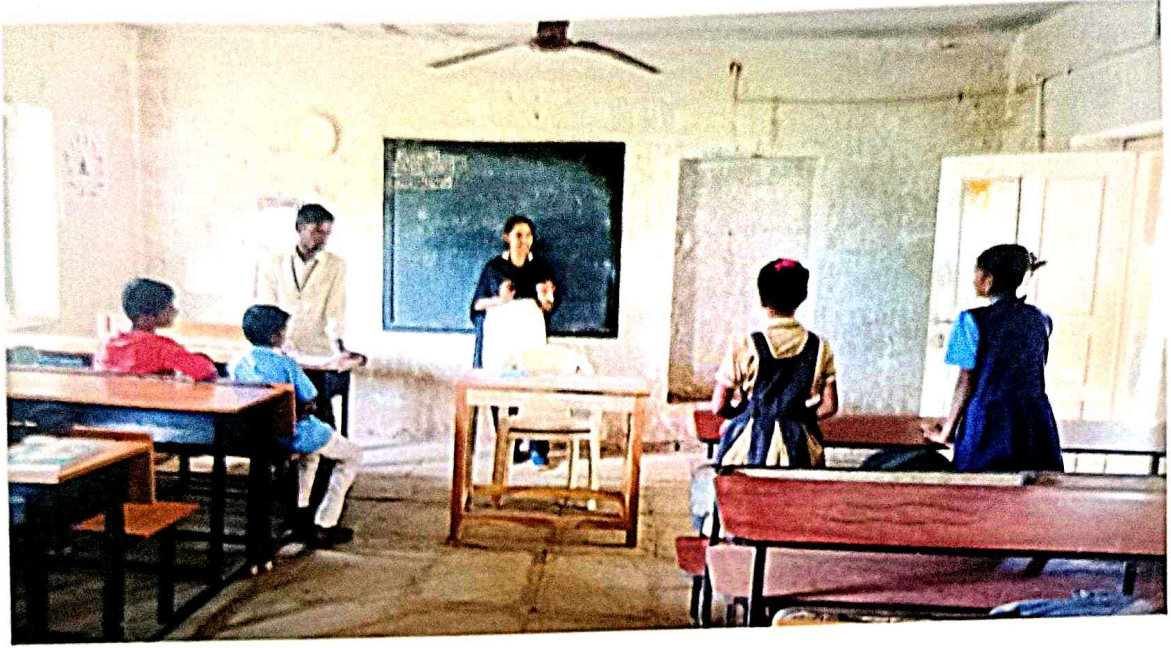

Abstract:

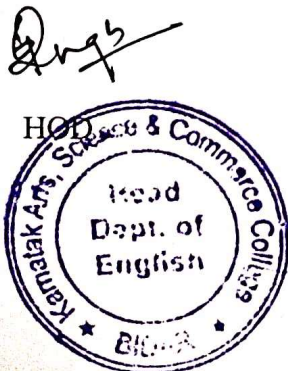
The department of English under Karnatak Arts, Science and Commerce College, Bidar had been given an opportunity to serve rural area students of government school to teach Grammar, Spoken English, and Communication Skills with absolute free of cost for a period of one month as a pilot programme. For this, one Asst. Prof. Anand Malgekar and a panel of 5 students were appointed to carry out this programme. The MOU signed on 4th of January 2022.

Objectives of the Programme:

1. Extend our activities of dealing with Grammar and Communication Skills to rural area students.
2. To extend our services to improve Govt. school in English Language.
3. To aware the knowledge of English literature with poems and short stories based on their syllabus.
4. To extend our students for teaching them grammar.
5. To train them spoken English from basic level.

Outcomes of the programme:

1. Students were well aware of English Grammar.
2. Students were taught Communication Skills.
3. They were acknowledged short stories poems of their syllabus.
4. They were trained Spoken English from basic level.
5. Students were able to read and write in English.
