Dear Piya Roy Choudhury,

We are pleased to inform you that your application titled "Study of algal biodiversity in Bidar District (Karnataka) and screening their efficacy in synthesizing iron nanoparticles" received under DBT's programme "Proposal for the use of Foldscope as a research tool" has been approved for funding by the Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science and Technology, Govt. of India.

The Department has granted Rs 8.00 lakhs for a period of 1 year for implementation of the project. The grant will be disbursed by NER-BPMC/BCIL in two installments.
