Institutional Scholarship Policy

Introduction: KRE Society's Karnatak Arts, Science and Commerce College Bidaris a premier institution and was founded to educate the local people of this Kalyan Karnataka area for their overall growth. The college's administration has decided to put in place a reward system for learners who exhibit a high level of merit during the course of their academic careers at KASCC. In addition to this incentive scheme, there are incentives given out at the beginning of the school year. It seeks to raise student intellectual rigor and maintain their focus on their chosen academic route. The structure for administering and distributing the Institutional Merit Cum Means Scholarships through the Poor Student Aid Fund (PSAF) and KRE Annapurna Scheme (Mid-Day Meal Scheme), which will be provided to students during their academic career at KASCC.

Additionally, College also offers the government scholarships through various schemes of central and state government.

Institutional Schemes:

- **Poor Students Aid Fund:** Poor Student Aid Fund is an institutional scholarship scheme offered by the college as collaborative effort of the management and permanent staff members through generous donation voluntarily from personal account.
- **KRE Annapurna (Mid-day Meal Scheme):** KRE Annapurna is mid-day meal scheme introduced to the students coming from rural and not easily accessible areas due to limited transportation facilities. As they travel early morning to reach the college on time and skip the breakfast, to serve such kind of students this scheme is introduced by KRE Society.
- **KRE President's Jivan Jyoti Insurance Scheme:** Due to the covid-19 pandemic institute has realized that health insurance is one of the important scheme required to be launched in college campus to serve the needy and economically weaker students.

Application Procedure:

For all the above three schemes of the institution candidate has to follow the steps given below:



1. At beginning of the academic year notification will be displayed on college website and student notice board
2. Eligible Students have to apply within given deadline as per format and instructions given in notification to the coordinator of the scheme.
3. Received applications are scrutinized and list of eligible candidates are called for counselling and document verification such income and merit.
4. Successful candidates are notified through notice board and requested amount will be disbursed through account payee cheque by the Principal.
