failure rates exceed those in older population groups. This reflects a number of barriers affecting youth entrepreneurship in areas including skills, networks and financing; barriers that are often particular to youth or more severe for youth than for adults. Youth entrepreneurship is not a panacea for solving the youth unemployment problem but it does have a role to play in facilitating both - employment and entrepreneurship development, hence it can be a part of the response. While context clearly matters, to maximize effectiveness and efficiency, policy should target resources on young people with the best chance of success, provide sufficient support to allow them to start businesses outside the low entry barrier but high competition sectors, and provide integrated packages of complementary support rather than one-shot instruments.


